

LAGREIN ROSATO

INDIGENOUS SELECTION

This wine is typical for South Tyrol and the expression of a special production of a great autochthonous grape variety. The grapes are carefully destemmed and slowly pressed. The short contact with the berry skins brings the colour into the must and we get a bright rose wine.

Name: The name Rosato refers to the rose-coloured wine.

Label: It shows a rose and refers to the floral notes as well as the rose colour of the Lagrein Rosato.

- Manual harvest, gentle slow pressing, maturation on the yeast for 6 months
- Aperitif, cold starters, pasta dishes, roasted fish
- Bright rose colour, delicate notes of rose, red fruits, smooth acidity, crisp freshness, well-balanced
