MÜLLER-THURGAU GASSNER AROMATIC SELECTION

At an altitude of about 900 m above sea level in one of the highest vineyards of South Tyrol grow the grapes for this Müller-Thurgau. The temperature in this vineyard is subject to variations, but the grape variety as a hybrid of Riesling and Silvaner benefits from this varied weather conditions.

Name: Gassner is the name of the farm where the vineyard is located.

Manual harvest, gentle pressing, fermentation in stainless steel, maturation on the yeast for 6 months
