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

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



From a Mediterranean climate to year-round snow-covered peaks, the winegrowing region of Südtirol / Alto Adige offers significantly contrasting climates. The fusion of these two cultures and regions results in a higher quality more enjoyable product. This creates an exciting symbiosis with a special "spirit" on the worldwide vinicultural scene. The versatility of the terroir and the unique Alpine-Mediterranean climate paired with longstanding tradition and innovation create an incomparable range of outstanding wines with strong character.

MULTIFACETED VINICULTURE

The vinicultural region in Northern Italy consists of about 5,400 hectares. Both soil conditions



and microclimates change in the space of a few kilometers, which is why growing grapes in Südtirol / Alto Adige is precision work. Each grape variety has its own demands on the climate, soil and altitude.

With more than 150 different rock types and the sustainable approach of the Südtirol / Alto Adige winegrowers, a natural balance is maintained. They plant vines at higher altitudes and consistently promote organic cultivation for future generations.

MODERN HANDCRAFT

The particularity of Alto Adige, besides the unmistakably high quality of the wine, is the discipline of the winegrowers and their closeness to nature. They create their unique wines out of passion for viniculture, precise handwork and innovative ideas.

AS IS GENERALLY KNOWN, GOOD VITICULTURE NEEDS TIME; 50 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN VITICULTURE AND THE DISCIPLINE AND ENERGY OF THE GIOVANETT FAMILY ARE THE BASIS OF THIS UNIQUE STORY.

Since the foundation of the Castelfeder Winery by Alfons Giovanett in 1969, many things have changed. The portfolio has been extended, production has been expanded, the winery's processes have been modernised and the market has become more international.

The winery, meanwhile in family hands for 3 generations, manifests its character from a symbiosis of tradition and pioneering spirit. "We are at a very good point in the history of the South Tyrolean wine business, now it is up to us to increase the popularity of our winery, to constantly work on the quality of the wines and not to lose focus on tradition": say Ines and Ivan Giovanett, the young generation in the family winery. Today, grapes from 65 hectares of vineyards are vinified in total. Approx. 70% oft them are white varieties with a concentration on Chardonnay, Pinot Blanc, Pinot Grigio and Sauvignon. The

remaining 30% are red grape varieties, and here the Pinot Noir is clearly in the focus. Although constantly confronted with new chal-





lenges due to climate change, market alterations and new trends in the wine business, the Giovanett family have managed to maintain the balance between tradition and modernity with great sensitivity.

For generations, the focus has been on selecting the best sites for their most important grape varieties. With regard to the next generations, there is a strong investment in sustainability, among other things.

Based on a constant pursuit of improvement and the vision to create top quality wines, 3 ranges have been created: **Burgum Novum; Castelfeder Selection; Mont Mès.**

An appealing freshness and vitality characterise the wines of the young Mont Mès line. The balance of elegance and lightness promises uncomplicated drinking pleasure.

A SPECIAL VINEYARD

12

The term "Vigna", followed by the traditional name of the vineyard, has the function in Italian wine law of certifying a production of one single vineyard. It can only be used for wines with Doc / Docg denomination. The alluvial cone at the northern end of the village of Salurn provides ideal conditions for growing Lagrein and Merlot and Chardonnay. The 8.5 hectares of vines we cultivate were therefore vinified separately for many years and provided with the traditional Villa Karneid label.

With the 2018 vintages these 3 wines were then incorporated into the Castelfeder Selections line to give them more visibility.

"TERROIR WINES WITH A SPECIAL CHARACTER"

With the 2018 vintage, two additional wines -Buchholz and Mazon - will be added to the Pinot Nero Glen. The new project focuses on the single sites Buchholz, Glen and Mazon: Their similarities, their differences and especially the fact that they are origin of three completely individual wines made of Pinot Nero.

THE SIMILARITIES: GLEN, MAZON, BUCHHOLZ

The three selected single sites of this special Pinot Nero project are all located on the cooler, eastern valley side of the South Tyrolean lowlands, at different altitudes between 450 and 790 m. The Pinot Nero vines grow on calcareous clay soils and are then vinified identically, so that the differences in terroir become even more apparent. Despite the geographical proximity of the three vineyard sites, Castelfeder thus succeeds in highlighting the different nuances and producing three wines of strong character.



THE THREE SINGLE SITES:

Buchholz: Main characteristic of this site is the fascinating geology, apart from the very cool climate.

The so-called faultline can be found- the faultline between calcareous dolomite rock and porphyry layers with a high content of red clay runs right through the vineyard. This offers the opportunity to extract this special single site wine.

Glen: Glen is the historically most important single site for the winery and extrends from 450 to 790 metres above sea level directly above Mazon. The ripening of the grapes is gradually retarded by up to 10 days every 100 metres of altitude. As a result, the staggered harvesting takes place over a very long period. The Pinot Nero Glen combines the strength and fruitiness of the lower vineyards with the freshness, elegance and finesse of the higher parcels.

Mazon: Mazon is known as the Grand Cru of Italian Pinot Nero. As a gentle plateau it is located at an altitude of 300 to 450 metres above sea level. The vineyard benefits from the long evening sun and cool down winds that cause a sudden drop of temperature in the evening. This special Pinot Nero Mazon stands out with its intensive colour, its voluminous-round character and its excellence structure.

SUCCESSFUL MOUNTAIN WINES SET AGAINST GOR-GEOUS LANDSCAPES

Trentino stretches from the glaciers of the Dolomites to the sunny shores of Lake Garda. The heart of the winegrowing region is the extended valley of the Adige, picturesquely framed by vineyards climbing up to 1,000 meters above sea level. The mountain scenery provides the best conditions for the cultivation of wines. The Adige Valley acts as a channel for the warm winds of the Mediterranean. Thanks to the climate of Lake Garda and the protective mountain flanks, late ripening grapes can flourish perfectly. With this exquisite base, the Trentino winegrowers can guarantee wines with internationally respected seals of quality based on passion and experience.



WIDE RANGE -**BESTSELLERS AND** TRADITIONAL VINES

The vines are spread over an area of 10,000 hectares, from which 70 million liters of wine are produced. 80% of Trentino wines have DOC status; 19 grape varieties are permitted: 9 white wine varieties and 10 red wine varieties. White wines account for the largest portion with 75%. Particularly notable among the red wines, are the autochthonous Teroldego and Marzemino wines and among the whites is the Nosiola grape. Its name comes from the Italian word "nocciola" for nut, which is reflected in the aroma profile of Nosiola DOC. A total of 22 local and international varieties are cultivated, with Chardonnay and Pinot Grigio being the best-selling varieties. The Marzemino is a medium-bodied wine with red brilliance, and a soft fruity harmony without much tannin. The Toreldego grape stands out with its purple color, powerful spicy taste and striking tannins.

The De Vescovi family has been growing wine in Mezzocorona in Campo Rotaliano for over four centuries. Giulio de Vescovi joined this great tradition after getting his degree in viticulture and oenology and founding the De Vescovi Ulzbach Winery. After having worked all over the world, he had the dream to use his knowledge and experience to create great wines from the Teroldego grape of his homeland. This autochthonous vine of the Rotaliana plain thrives especially well on the fertile, alluvial, and gravel soils protected by the mountains. In order to achieve his goal of producing the highest quality wine, Giulio is particularly concerned about respecting the land itself. The wines thus combine tradition and region, modernity and history in the best possible way.

FAMOUS FOR A WIDE VARIETY OF WINES

The hilly landscape between Verona and Venice is one of the most important wine-growing regions with 75,000 hectors of vineyards. Geographically it is the most diverse as the climate offers an interaction of cool Alpine air and Mediterranean influences. The cooler zones and altitudes are best suitable for white wines, while the warmer plains of the Adriatic coast are primarily home to red grape varieties.

RED CLASSICS, SOAVE AND PROSECCO

On the right bank of Lake Garda, the Bardolino feels particularly at home on the morainic hills. The Soave and Valpolicella like the tufa soils of the Lessini Mountains and the Prosecco finds the best soils in the Treviso Mountains. DOC/DOCG wines account for 60% of the total production and 25% of all of Italy. The red wines Valpolicella and



VENETO

Bardolino must be made from 80% Rondinella and Corvina Veronese grapes. The rich Amarone, on the other hand, is made from air-dried grapes. Its sweet variety is the Recioto. In the Ripasso, the wet skins of the Amarone grapes are fermented once again, giving more fruit, elegance and strength. The lighter Bardolino stands out for its fresh fragrance and fine fruit; its rosé version, the Chiaretto, is also very popular. The Soave is the best known of the white varieties. "Soave" means sweet, gentle and that's how it tastes. It is made from 70% Garganega grapes and 30% other grapes such as the Trebbiano. The other pride is the Prosecco made from the Glera grape, which comes as Prosecco Superiore DOCG and Prosecco DOC from the very centers of Valdobbiadene and Cinegliano.

ENTIRE PROSECCO PRODUCTION IN FAMILY HANDS

The vineyards of the Spagnol Family Winery are spread out over the most suitable hills and slopes of the DOCG Conegliano Valdobbiadene. Since the foundation of the winery in the early 20th century, the immediate family has run the 34.5-hectare estate. Each grape is cared for on the vine, harvested by hand and monitored on its way to the bottle. They are proud of the fact that the entire cycle of winemaking, including the foaming, for which the Martinotti method is used, can be carried out on the estate. All the vineyards are located in the province of Treviso, where two areas stand out: the first is a monument to the history of the local grape variety Glera in Solighetto di Pieve di Soligo. The second vineyard, "Col del Sas", is the symbol of the firm bond between the family and the land. The development of sustainable cultivation is particularly important here. For new vineyards, the

oldest vines are recovered from the land, as these plants are already perfectly adapted to the environment. The aim is to support the preservation and enhancement of biodiversity.

In rural Valpolicella, in the middle of a small natural paradise among green olive trees and sun-kissed vines, Albino Sella founded the San Cassiano Winery in 1964, initially with only a few hectares of land. In this young and enthusiastic winery the traditional Valpolicella is interpreted with patience, enthusiasm and respect for the land. The production of Valpolicella wines follows tradition and the desire for typicality while also accompanied by modern winemaking and the young philosophy of the company: the search for the perfect synthesis between variety, soil, construction and winemaking technique. Since every vineyard should have its own specific wine, the characteristics are carefully considered in all stages of production. The idea: each wine is a photograph of the vineyard to which it belongs.

This is an excellent description for this great wine-growing region, as the foothills of the Alps frame the area on three sides: bordered by Switzerland to the north, Genoa to the south and then France to the west - putting it in the best company for high-quality viticulture.

LOW QUANTITY, HIGHEST QUALITY

The picturesque hilly landscape forms a natural barrier to the Mediterranean influences. To the east the vineyards extend into the flat Po Valley, offering a variety of terroirs in what is probably Italy's most desirable wine region. The dreamlike landscape alone is enchanting, but the wines also impress with their high quality. In total, the wine-growing area extends over 48,000 hectares and provides about 3 million hectoliters of wine per year. The wines of Piedmont are extremely full of character and achieve a quality only possible here.



CLASSIC RED WINE COUNTRY

With a production of almost 90% red wine varieties, Piemonte is classic red wine country. At the top of the ranking are the famous Barolo and Barbaresco wines made from the Nebbiolo grape; the fruity Barbera is also particularly prized. The great Barolo finds the best ripening conditions in the calcareous soils near the Alba. The slightly more elegant Barbaresco grows where the temperatures are a bit warmer and the soils are slightly different.

Among the trendy white wines of Piemonte there are the delicately fruity and flowery Gavi from the Cortese di Gavi grape variety, as well as the Arneis with its honey-reminiscent bouquet.

In Piedmont, on the hills between Serralunga d'Alba and Sinio, Enrico Rivetto runs his Tenuta Lirano with a vision that has matured over the years: creating healthy and enjoyable wines with the maximum reflection of the vine variety and the territory.

The passion for and knowledge of wine has been in the family for 4 generations, but Enrico has his own clear vision: a production method using purely biodynamic techniques, viticulture in harmony with nature, land and man, resulting in a vineyard that is in balance with the entire ecosystem. He considers the key to be the diversification of cultures by cultivating different plants and herbs through the vineyard. Vinification is also done with a minimum amount of intervention. The winery is located at 400 meters above sea level on the border of the Barolo Zone and the estate owns 15 hectares of vineyards in total. Here in the Serralunga area,

the soil is calcareous and rich in clay and marl, which provide the richness, strength and elegance of the tannins in the Barolos.

Lombardy is bordered on the north by the Swiss High Alps and extends south to the banks of the Po. The wonderful lake region and continental influences create a special microclimate. The wines get their full aroma from the cold winters and hot summers with additional frequent rainfall in the spring and autumn. For a more favorable ripening process, the vines are mostly grown on south-facing slopes, which provide them with more sunlight. From a geological point of view, ideal conditions prevail due to the sparseness of the soil and the great aeration capacity.

In total the vineyard is spread across three areas that are best suited for viticulture. But in the mountainous and hilly landscapes between Ber-



gamo and Brescia, from the western and southern shores of Lake Garda come the most delicious red, white, rosé and sparkling wines, which are among the best and most remarkable of all the Italian wines.

LOWEST HARVEST, HIGHEST QUALITY

Altogether this results in a small vineyard area of 27,000 hectares, which produces about 1.6 million hectoliters of wine per year. Light rosé or red wines represent over 90% of the wine production. In contrast, the Lugana growing region on the southern shores of Lake Garda is known for the most impressive white wines of Lombardy. The Trebbiano di Lugana grape variety produces fine, spicy yet uncomplicated wines here.

GENTLY SLOPING VINEYARDS ON THE BANKS OF LAKE GARDA

The Monte Cicogna family business is located in Lombardy, in the village of Moniga del Garda on the Brescian side of the western shore of Lake Garda. The winery was founded by Pietro Materossi in 1908 and today the fourth generation of his family is still running the farm with the same philosophy and commitment. Alessandro is the master of the vineyards and the cellar, while Cesare oversees administration. Both are mindful of the traditional values, the family passion, and the secrets in their work, preserving the same excellence of the past for the future. Around the farm and the manor house, in an elevated position overlooking the lake, on a hillside gently declining towards the shore, their vineyards and olive groves are in an extremely exposed position. Other vines are located inland near Monte Cicogna, the wooded hill that gives the farm its name. The influence of the lake and the wooded hills behind it create a Mediterranean microclimate perfect



Its distinctive logo with a castellated letter F distinguishes its wines and refers back to the ancient mediaeval towers that characterise 19 municipalities in the heart of Lombardy, by the shores of Lake Iseo: Adro, parts of Brescia, Capriolo, Cazzago San Martino, Cellatica, Coccaglio, Cologne, Corte Franca, Erbusco, Gussago, Iseo, Monticelli Brusati, Ome, Paderno Franciacorta, Paratico, Passirano, Provaglio, Rodengo Saiano and Rovato.


In 1997 the first bottles of Franciacorta Docg were released and from then on these exclusive sparkling wines have had a huge growth worldwide. After harvest and fermentation these base wines are assembled together to create the cuvée, a blend of Franciacorta varieties, even of different vintages, that are selected following careful tasting. The following spring the base wine is bottled for the tirage. A mixture of yeasts and sugar is added to the wine in the bottle, they are sealed with a crown cup and the wine undergoes a slow natural refermentation inside the bottle. They are laid down horizontally in dark cellar and remain on the yeast for at least 18 months.

THERE'S MORE THAN JUST LAMBRUSCO...

ALLUVIAL PLAINS AND HILLY SLOPES

The double region is nestled between the Adriatic Sea to the east, the Romagna, and the Emilia, which extends westwards into the countryside. The Po River is the natural northern border; to the south, the Apennines form the boundary with Tuscany. The climate is moderately warm: in summer temperatures can reach 38 °C, while in the cool winter frost can occur. Most of the 58,000 hectares of vineyards are located in the large alluvial plains, but the hilly areas on the southern border of the Apennines are best suited for viticulture.

CUISINE MEETS LAMBRUSCO

The wine production quantity is 8-9 million hectoliters, about 15% of the total Italian production. There are 2 DOCG and 19 DOC areas. Around Parma culinary traditions are clearly in the spotlight: Parmesan cheese from Reggio, the famous ham from Parma and the balsamic vinegar from Modena. The most famous wine of the area, Lambrusco, is a popular accompaniment. These are sparkling red and rosé wines made from different Lambrusco varieties, often with a distinct residual sweetness. However, there are also pleasingly high-quality dry exceptions with a bouquet of red fruits and floral notes.

DOCG WINES MADE FROM SANGIOVESE GRAPES

In Romagna, viticulture extends right up to the Adriatic Sea. The Sangiovese di Romagna grapes particularly characterize the red wines. Compared to the famous Tuscany wine, it is a little lighter and less tannic. The best vineyards are found in the hills near Rimini.

Since 1858 the Branchini familiy has been running their Branchini Winery "Cardinala Nuova" in the Emilia-Romagna region.

High-quality wines are produced due to their knowledge and passion in cultivating the vineyards, combined with the technology in the cellar. The 24 hectares of land of the Branchini Winery are framed by three rivers, the Rio Sabbioso, the Sillaro and the Sellustra, which have characterised, over the centuries, the geological composition of the soil and thus the typicality of the wine.

HEAVENLY RIPENING CONDITIONS

Tuscany is one of the most famous wine growing regions in the world. This fascinating cultural landscape is bordered to the northeast by the Apennine Mountains and extends west to the Tyrrhenian coast. The vineyards extend over approximately 58,000 hectares, which can be found on sun-drenched slopes at 100-500 meters. Optimal geological and climatic conditions due to barren calcareous soils and volcanic formations create unique mineral notes in the wine and produce the highest qualities. Thanks to the different types of soil, the winegrowers can grow a unique assortment of excellent red wine varieties.

SANGIOVESE - POPULAR SINCE ROMAN TIMES

Tuscany is also among the oldest wine-growing regions in Europe. The Romans themselves praised one grape in particular, the Sangiovese. Italy's most famous and most produced quality wine, Chianti, is nowadays more and more made from pure Sangiovese. Traditionally however, a proportion of up to 20% of other grape varieties is also allowed, which is why Chianti wines with Cuvees from Canaiolo Nero to Merlot can also be found. The highlight of the white wines is the Vernaccia di San Gimignano vine, but Chardonnays and Sauvignon blancs can also produce fine results. Altogether, Tuscany has the largest assortment of grapes in the world with over 2000 varieties. Altogether up to 40 percent of DOC or DOCG wines are vinified here.





NOT JUST DREAM BEACHES, **BUT ALSO DREAM WINES**

GRAPE VARIETIES AS UNIQUE AS THE SARDINIANS THEMSELVES

Sardinia is the second largest island in the Mediterranean. Mountains and plateaus with clayey soils cover most of the island. The 32,000 hectares of vineyards are mainly spread over the gentle hilly plains. In the cooler north, fresh and fruity white wines flourish; the warm southern and western areas are ideal for red and dessert wines. In the flat plains, the vines are trained according to the traditional Albarello, Gobelet-Tree method.

ISLAND WINES WITH A HIGH ALCOHOL CONTENT

The annual quantity of wine is about 1 million hectoliters and 12% of the wines carry the DOC/ DOCG classification. A remarkable number of wines have a high alcohol content, but exceptionally fine products can also be found, such as the



first-rate products made from the Vermentino di Gallura grape; a full-bodied, very fruit-intensive and racy wine, the first and only Sardinian wine with DOCG certification. The Nuragus di Cagliari from the autochthonous grape variety Nuragus is also worth mentioning. The name comes from the ancient Sardinian stone towers know as Nuraghi.

GRAPE VARIETIES INFLUENCED BY **IMMIGRANTS**

Throughout history, immigrants have brought new grape varieties, with the Spanish notably having the greatest influence. They've enriched today's range of grape varieties with the Garnacha grape, now known in Sardinia as Cannonau di Sardegna. A fine fruit as well as complexity and body characterize their wines. Today, enthusiastic winegrowers produce excellent qualities from them. Thus Sardinia has grape varieties that are as individual as the Sardinians themselves.





VERDICCHIO AND THE ROSSOS IMPRESS

HILLY MAINLAND, GENTLE COAST

The eastern wine region stretches beautifully along 170 km of the Adriatic coast. The 25,000 hectares of vineyards are mostly located in the hilly central region on slopes with clayey soil. In addition, there are vineyards close to the coast on mainly calcareous soils with marine sediments. Thanks to the influence of the Mediterranean Sea and the proximity of the mountains, a cool, temperate climate is generated. The annual wine production reaches 1.6 million hectoliters; the red wines are slightly above the white wines in terms of quantity.

DELICATE WHITES, DASHING REDS

Of the white wines, the most famous is the Verdicchio from the Castelli di Jesi area, and it is the pride of the winemakers. This autochthonous grape variety has adapted particularly well to the conditions and produces a very delicate, fresh and fruity wine with powerful acidity. The

typical almond aftertaste is especially wonderful. If you want to highlight vines among the red wines, you must look to the southern regions. One of the most important is the Rosso Piceno, which contains 60% Sangiovese. It is found on the hills of Ascoli Piceno and tastes floral-berry to chocolate-dark. In addition, the top wine from the coastal region, the Rosso Conero, a pure Montepulciano, produces beautiful qualities with character and powerful tannins. It grows on the slopes of Monte Conero, where the steep coast and the turquoise blue sea form picturesque scenery. Another red wine specialty is Lacrima di Morro D'Alba. Only a few wineries dedicate themselves to the autochthonous Lacrima grape (English: tears), which produces exciting results with firm tannins and a distinctive, spicy aroma.

WINES OF GREAT LOCAL IMPORTANCE

MOUNTAIN WINES WITH CHARACTER

Situated east to Rome, Abruzzo extends 130 km along the beautiful shores of the Adriatic coast. With peaks of up to 3000m the Apennines cover the majority of Abruzzo, so that almost two thirds of the country is mountainous, and the other third hilly countryside. The viticulture is mostly done in high altitudes of up to 600m. The temperate climate found in these Mediterranean foothills and hilly country is quite advantageous, as the balance of sun and coolness allows rich but not excessively heavy wines to be produced. The approximately 33,000 hectares of the vineyard is rooted in lime, clay, sand or gravel soils.

DOMINANCE OF LOCAL GRAPE VARIETIES

Nowadays, viniculture holds relatively high local importance. 90% of the 4 million hectoliters of wine produced here are drunk directly on site, although in terms of total production, Abruzzo ranks fifth in Italy. The quality of wines has improved noticeably in recent years. Among the eight wines with DOC classification, two types of grapes dominate the scene: Trebbiano d'Abruzzo, which is used for white wines and Montepulciano d'Abruzzo which is used for the reds. The first is a very attractive, delicately fruity and medium-weight white wine, which can produce fine qualities from older vineyards. The Montepulciano d'Abruzzo grape, which needs a lot of sun and a long ripening period, impresses with its cherry fruit, spicy aromas and mineral notes. Due to the strong tannins it is also suitable for barrique maturation. An interesting alternative to the light white wines is the Rosé version of Montepulciano. The Cerasuolo is an intensely bright, berry-fruity Rosé, which makes for excellent summer wines.



GRAN-SASSO D'ITALIA

Abruzzo is dominated by the Apennines, having its highest peaks here with the 2914 m Corno Grande in the Gran Sasso d'Italia massif and the 2975 m Monte Amaroim Maiella mountain chain. The few flat areas are situated reassuringly high above sea level. The climatic conditions vary from cool and humid in the high inland, which is exposed to the influences of the sea from both sides, to constantly warmer and drier down to the 129 km long Adriatic coast. Viticulture partly takes place at high altitudes. Most of the vineyards are situated in the hills on calcareous clay soil along the Adriatic Sea, with air circulation even during the usual summer drought.

HUGE VINEYARDS AND **GREAT HARVESTS**

The heel and spur of Italy's boot are scenically marked by the 350 km of coastline as well as the plateaus and lowlands. Most of the vineyards are located near the coast, where only slight day/night temperature differences occur. The geology is characterized mainly by limestone, clay and sandstone. Apulia is perhaps the oldest wine-growing region in Italy; in fact the Phoenicians and Greeks were already planting vines in 3000 BC. With about 107,000 hectares of vineyards and a wine production of 8-10 million hectoliters, Apulia is one of the largest wine-growing regions in Italy. Quality wines represent about 10% of the total production.

STRONG RED WINE RESULTS

Apulia is pleased to have many autochthonous grape varieties, which have a high importance here. Among the whites, the Bombino Bianco and Verdeca vines are notable and produce local specialties. However Apulia, with three quarters of its territory, is clearly red wine country. Very interesting results can be found among the autochthonous varieties of the Negroamaro, Primitivo and Uva di Troia, or the slightly rarer Malvasia Nera. The Negroamoro from the Salento Peninsula often produces outstanding wines with fine aromas, as the strong sea breezes soften the glistening heat a bit. The wines from the Nero di Troia vine are especially popular because the grapes ripen late and thus have a long time to develop their aromas. The best Primitivo wines, with DOCG seals, come from the area around Manduria, which produces fruity, spicy wines that have often seen barriques.

FOCUS ON LOCAL GRAPE VARIETIES

THE MOST SOUTHERN WINE-GROWING REGION

The largest island in the Mediterranean Sea is located in front of the boot tip of Italy and possesses a 1000 km long coastline. The Sicilian Apennines and the volcano Etna characterize the inland. The climate is Mediterranean with little rainfall. In the central part a harsher mountain climate governs the nature. In general there are excellent conditions for viticulture, as the barren stony soils, some of which are of volcanic origin, are ideal for the vines. Often the vineyards are located on slopes of up to 900 m above sea level. Sicily, together with Apulia, is the largest wine-growing region in Italy and produces 10 million hectoliters per year. There is only one DOCG zone, but 20 DOC areas, whose development is prosperously advanced. As a denomination of origin all DOC wines have the addition "Sicilia" on the label; for IGT wines "Terre Siciliane".



NEW WAYS FOR SICILY'S WINE MAKERS

Due to the hot climate, one would assume that red grapes dominate the 150,000 hectares of vineyards, but white wines have the upper hand with 64% of the territory. Today, many winemakers are going new ways and highlighting the advantages of the local grape varieties, such as the Nero d' Avola, Nerello Mascalese or the white varieties such as the Inzolia, Grillo or Catarratto. They are regarded as strong, but finely aromatic with fragrant notes and are among the best in Italy. The red Nero D'Avola deserves special attention as the rising star of the Italian wine scene. They are spicy, fruity, structured wines that are especially enjoyable in summer. New plantings are already showing fine results, and have positioned Sicily for a great future ahead.





THE HOME OF RIESLING

The Mosel is considered to be the largest cultivation area regarding Riesling. Almost half of the winearea is planted with it - and its region's top wines are famous all over the world. Nowhere else this wine is produced in such a filigree, delicate yet concentrated way. The steep slopes of the Moselle, on slate weathered soils, are certainly a unique characteristic and help the Riesling to its worldwide fame. Moselle Rieslings do not impress with their fullness, but rather with their light, slender style and the distinct tendency to produce a fine fruit.

RACIAL WINE-GROWING AREA

The Saar has a very special, cooler microclimate. Probably no other region in Germany shines with



racier Rieslings. In difficult vintages, the wines have to struggle with high acidity to achieve an ideal balance. In warm years, however, they unite the crystal-clear, juicy Riesling fruit, restulting in filigree masterpieces with a racy acidity.

SLATE SOIL STEEP SLOPES

The entire cultivation are dominated by sate soils, consisting of many different types of slate. The proportion of steep slopes is very high and a slope gradient of 70% is not unusual. A mechanized treatment of the vines is only possible to a limited extent, which means that the extensive manual work in the vineyards still predominates. The valley of the curvy Moselle is particularly narrow and steep. Here the heat is well stored and is available to the vines, which are protected from the wind, for a long time.

SORENTBERG - UNIQUE RIESLINGS WITH A LONG YEAR HISTORY OF ENGAGED YOUNG **WINEMAKERS**

In the famous German Riesling wine-growing region of Mosel, situated in an idyllic side valley, two young winemakers have brought a very special single vineyard to new life. This small vineyard, or more accurately an extremely steep south-facing slope, had been forgotten for over 25 years, until Tobias Treis and Ivan Giovanett had the idea to restore it by hand. Here the approximately 9.5 hectares of Riesling vines are rooted in an excellent, unique soil type, which is interspersed with a special red slate. This, togeth-SORENTBERG. P. er with the cool climate,

provides the distinctive flavor of the ESLING.D Riesling produced here.

A WINE LIKE NO OTHER

The Sorentberg site is the only vineyard in all of Mosel to have the exceptional "Wissenbach slate" in the soil. This red slate soil also has inclusions of shell limestone. The State Office for Geology in Mainz has confirmed that in all of Mosel these unique rocks of the Middle Devonian age can only be found in the Sorentberg soil, making their Riesling wine incomparable and unique. Other exceptional features of this site include a 100% south-facing slope with an average grade of up to 110% and the extremely good ventilation with a cool climate due to its location in the side valley.





RECULTIVATION OF OLD VINES

When the vineyard slopes on the Sorentberg were being recultivated, a big surprise came to light. In the uppermost section, situated on an extremely steep hillside, the two young winemakers found old vines in and amongst the wilderness that reigned there. These vines turned out to be almost 100 years old. Out of great curiosity to see whether these vines would still be able to produce wine after 25 years of abandonment, they were extensively cleaned and replanted. To everyone's great delight, the vines actually did sprout again in 2012.

The further processing of the grapes in the cel-

lar is deliberately carried out according to traditional craft. The vinification methods are classical and not influenced by trends, as they look to the values of earlier winemakers to inform their work. In addition to the appreciation of the terroir, these include, among other things, strictly hand harvesting, spontaneous fermentation in traditional wooden barrels and absolutely no wine treatment agents. This is important to them in order to express the origin and thus the personality of Sorent at its best. Naturally the winegrowers are concerned with creating wine of the highest quality, which means avoiding any methods that are suitable for mass production.

TWO YOUNG WINEGROWERS FULFILL A DREAM

The two young men Tobias Treis and Ivan Giovanett met while studying viticulture at the prestigious Geisenheim University. Afterwards, their paths initially separated, as they each returned home to their parents' traditional wineries: Julius Treis (Reil/Mosel) and Castelfeder (South Tyrol). Only in 2011 would the young winemakers' long-awaited dream of growing their own top-quality Riesling wine be fulfilled. Full of commitment and enthusiasm they recultivated the forgotten traditional single vineyard site of Sorentberg on the Middle-Mosel and channeled their passion for the Riesling into their own wine. Using new methods as well as their knowledge from two different countries they created an unmistakable top Riesling from the Mosel region.



The spectacular steep slopes here are mainly dedicated to Riesling and can only be cultivated by hand. The backbreaking work in the vineyard is carried out in harmony with nature and is driven by idealism and the pursuit of the highest quality. The Treis family has been involved in viticulture since 1684 and every generation has loved and lived viticulture. Today, the trained oenologist Tobias Trei, with his skill, passion, idealism and innovative ideas, gives the wines his own personal signature. The wealth of traditional knowledge of the terroir, the peculiarities of the vineyards, legendary stories and fine skills are reflected in his wines. The origin and the fine differences between HH.JULIUS-TRE the vintages can be tasted in every wine, because the individual maturation process in the cellar preserves the unique character of each vineyard. info
